

# PROJECT SPOTLIGHT Powerchair Drive-Up Workstation

Andrew needed support for his computer monitor and keyboard to work sitting in his power chair, tilted back at a comfortable attitude. For Andrew, the tilt is about 20 degrees from the vertical, which raises his knees and feet and prevents him from pulling up to an ordinary desk or table.





The solution was to suspend the computer monitor and keyboard mid-air, allowing Andrew to drive up and park his power chair under them. A commercially available computer monitor support was mounted on a custom-made cabinet, which supports Andrew's laptop computer and provides convenient storage space.

The project was completed in October 2019 by volunteer Carl Anderson, Halifax NS Tetra Society.

If you or a loved one needs an assistive device, please submit a request for assistance on our website. You will be asked to provide some background information about yourself, your disability and your requirements. It helps to have researched commercial devices to be sure that no alternative is available. You will NOT be required to forward additional materials like medical documents.
